Our society's Calendar of Events utilizes "Google Calendar" which allows you to conveniently view the time and date details of an upcoming event. When you place your mouse cursor over an event, you then view a "pop-up" which provides event details and other important information to help you decide if you want to become a participant. Hopefully, the sponsor will provide you with more detailed information on how to contact them, the cost, if they provide CE credits or units, how to sign-up for the event, etc. You also have the option of [subscribing](#) to the calendar in order to have events automatically added to your iCal, Google, Outlook or other compatible calendar application. After review, your event will appear on the calendar. Please allow at least one week from receipt for your event information for it to appear on the calendar.

Posting Guidelines and Disclaimer

The BSC Calendar of Events (hereafter “Calendar”) is maintained by the Board of Directors of the Biofeedback Society of California and the education subcommittee, (hereafter “BSC”). BSC offers free listing of events such as workshops, conferences, seminars, etc. on the Calendar for its members. We welcome all BSC members and any person, group, or organization to offer to post information about their upcoming events on the BSC Calendar, subject to the conditions described below.

Educational events posted on the Calendar must be relevant and of interest to members of the Biofeedback Society of California or the wider applied psychophysiology community. Event(s) on the Calendar are screened for content by BSC. BSC reserves the right to deny the posting of any event on the Calendar that is deemed inappropriate. Screening criteria require all events to be grounded in empirical science and to utilize methods and procedures that are accepted by consensus in the biofeedback field. Events or sponsoring organizations with known histories of unethical or highly controversial practices may not post their event information on this Calendar. The Calendar is offered for informational purposes only. The BSC will review the information submitted regarding the event as well as the event’s sponsor to assure that all BSC guidelines have been followed and that the information is accurate. However, BSC makes no guarantee or assurance that the posted information is accurate or current. BSC recommends that those using information obtained from the Calendar should contact the person(s) or organization(s) who are sponsoring an event to obtain the most accurate and up-to-date information regarding the event. The BSC is not responsible for any losses incurred, financial or other, associated with the use or misuse of information contained on the Calendar or for any losses associated with an errors, omissions, or misrepresentations in the information provided about an event. Event information, including posting only the most current course content description(s) and related details about the event are the sole responsibility of the person(s) or organization(s) posting or sponsoring the event. Events will only be posted that are clearly identified with a responsible party; events not clearly identified and associated with a responsible party will not be posted to the Calendar.

Events that are sponsored or endorsed by BSC must be approved by the Board of Directors, or the Board’s approved agent(s) prior to posting it on the Calendar. Events posted on the Calendar should not be understood to mean or imply that the BSC sponsors or endorses the event. Likewise, any courses, workshops, lectures, or seminars that are approved for continuing education units or credits by BSC, does not automatically mean that the BSC is sponsoring or endorsing the event. If BSC approved an event for CE units or credits an event posting on the Calendar may state that BSC has approved the event and is providing or administrating CE units or credits. However, nowhere in the event’s details may it indicate or imply that the BSC is sponsoring or endorsing the event. When the BSC, or the Board’s approved agent(s), approves BSC’s sponsorship and/or endorsement of an event, they provide an approval letter to document this. If the event sponsor has this document he or she may the state this approval in the event details. Any statements in the event description that wrongly implies BSC’s sponsorship or endorsement may, at the BSC’s discretion, be corrected prior to being announced or, in some cases, for repeat violators, their event(s) may not be allowed to be posted on and BSC Calendar of Events.

To better serve our members, BSC may re-post events on the BSC Calendar as long as the information about the event had already been made a matter of public record by being posted or announced elsewhere. When a re-post does not match BSC guidelines for posting, BSC reserves the right to edit the event description. Those individuals or groups who do NOT want to have their event re-posted on BSC’s Calendar, or do NOT want their event description edited to match our posting guidelines, may do so by contacting [{Click Me}](#). However, those individuals or groups will then forfeit their ability to post future notices regarding upcoming events on the BSC Calendar for a period of time determined by the Board of BSC or the Board’s approved agent(s).
